






Arms.—Quarterly, 1st and 4th, az. three leopards' heads, (af-frontée,) coupé at the neck, or.
2d and 3d, Ar. two branches sa. each charged with a leopard's head or.
Crest.—On a mount vert, a stag, lodged, ermine, attired or, resting the dexter fore foot upon a fleur-de-lis, erect, or.
These Arms and Crest were exemplified to Denne Denne, Esq. late Hollingbery, on his change of name in 1822.
Note.—These Coats were both borne separately by different branches of the family of DENNE.

SIR ALURED DENNE, Knt.
Seneschal of the Priory of Christ - Church, Canterbury, and Escheator of the county of Kent, 19th Henry III. 1234, son of William Denne, of East Kent, living in the time of King John.

Denne Hollingbery, now Denne Denne, Esq. of Elbridge, in the parish of Littlebourn, aforesaid; took the surname and arms of DENNE only, by royal sign manual, Aug. 1822. Elizabeth, daur. of Richard Pembroke, of Littlebourn, mar. there in 1824.

Emma, eldest daur. born in 1825, bapt. at Littlebourn. Eliza-Mary, born in 1827, bapt. at Littlebourn.
